Instructions for Naxos Music Library: the online music database.

(You will be prompted for your myneu username and password if you are off-campus.)

NAXOS has the following Search Modes

- **Genre Search** (Classical, Jazz, World Music, Chinese, New Age, Pop)
- **Browse Search** (Keyword, disc, composition title, artist)
- **Advanced search**, (multi-field searching)
- **Playlists** for assigned class listening.

Bookmarks:

You may experience difficulties logging in if you have bookmarked the Naxos web page. To fix this problem:

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Right click on the Naxos bookmark
3. Select "properties"
4. If you see "default.asp" at the end of the URL, delete it, so that the bookmark points to one of the URL's above

OS: Mac OS X 10.3.5 / OS 10.2.8 with [MS IE 5.2](#) / [Mozilla 1.7](#) / [Netscape 7.1](#) / [Opera 7.53](#) / and [Media Player 9.0](#);

or OS 8.6 / 9.0 with [MS IE 5.1](#) and [Media Player 7.1](#)

Browser Settings: Privacy = Medium, Cookies = Accept, Sound Effect = No.

Internet:

A higher Internet bandwidth means you can choose a better sound quality.

The minimum requirements are:

Broadband for 128Kbps streaming (CD quality)

DSL or ISDN for 64Kbps streaming (near CD quality)

Dial-up connection for 20Kbps streaming (FM quality)

Network:

Allow ANY in and ANY out traffic for ports 1755, 554 and 80 in your proxy/firewalls, and no NAT or PAT.

File Format:

Naxos sound files are in MS WMA 9.0 format

Time-out setting:

There is a 15-minute inactivity time-out—a pop-up window will appear on your screen a minute or two before the time-out goes into effect asking if you wish to continue your session. Click the "yes" button, and the audio streaming will continue without interruption. If no response is given, the session may terminate, so it is important to keep an eye on your monitor when listening to extended works such as operas, oratorios, and lengthy symphonic works. Please CLOSE YOUR BROWSER after you log out of Naxos
